
## 第一課 Colossians 1:1-14


V1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, V2 To the holy and faithful <u>brothers</u> at Colosse: Grace and peace to you from God our Father. V3 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, V4 because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all the saints— V5 the faith and love † that spring from the hope that is stored up in heaven and that you have already heard about in the word of truth, the gospel ♦ that has come to you. V6 All over the world this gospel is bearing fruit and growing, T just as it has been doing among you since the day 'you <u>heard</u> it understood God's grace in all its truth. V7 You <u>learned</u> it **♠**from Epaphras, our dear fellow servant, who is a faithful minister of Christ on our behalf, V8 who also told us of your love in the Spirit.





## V15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. V16 For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. V17 He is before all things, and **√**in him all things hold together. V18 And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, in everything he might have the supremacy. V19 For God was pleased ▲ to have all his fullness dwell in him, and $\downarrow$ through him V20 to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. **♦**Once V21 you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. V22 But now he has reconciled you ♦ by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish free from accusation— V23 if <u>you</u> continue in <u>your faith</u>, established and firm, not moved from the hope Theld out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to <u>every creature</u> under heaven and of which I, Paul, have become a servant. 3

## 第三課 V24 Now I rejoice in what was suffered for you, and I fill up in my flesh ▲ what is still <u>lacking</u> in regard to Christ's afflictions, for the sake of his body, which is the church. V25 I have become its servant by the <u>commission</u> **♦** God gave me to present to you the word of God in its fullness— V26 the mystery ↑that <u>has been kept hidden</u> Tfor ages and generations, but <u>is now disclosed</u> to the saints. V27 To them among the Gentiles God has chosen to make known the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. V28 We <u>proclaim</u> him, <u>**admonishing**</u> and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect in Christ. V29 **▼**To this end I labor, struggling with all his energy, which so powerfully works in me. I want you to know how much I am struggling **≜**for you and for those at Laodicea, for all who have not met me personally. V2 My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, V3 ▲in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
